## Course Description

### **Fundamentals of SI Theory: Application to Practice**

**Course Code: CA-20B-04**

*This course will introduce practitioners to the fundamentals of sensory integration theory. The underlying principles of sensory integration will be discussed. The neuroanatomy essential for understanding sensory integration and its application to intervention will be presented in an easy to understand format which will be linked to function throughout the course. The basic neurology and function of the sensory modulation, sensory discrimination and motor systems will be addressed. This course will form a solid foundation for understanding sensory integration intervention. This course is ideal for the practitioner who wants a solid overview of sensory integration theory and neurology that is meaningfully applied to intervention.*

### **Introduction to SI Intervention for Adolescents and Adults with Disabilities**

**Course Code: AE-20B-03**

*This course will provide an overview of sensory integration intervention as applied to individuals with autism and multiple disabilities throughout the lifespan. Special emphasis will be given to application of sensory integration principles to adolescents and adults with disabilities. The relation of various factors such as diagnoses, medications, and behaviors to sensory integration problems will be discussed. Sensory integration intervention principles and strategies for developing sensory diet programs for this population will be presented. Information will be presented in an on-line lecture format with ample case study examples and opportunities for participant questions.*

**Dr. Teresa A. May-Benson, Sc.D., OTR/L, Owner of TMB Education, LLC and OTR, Inc., is a well-known lecturer and researcher on sensory integration. She is the author of the Adult/Adolescent Sensory History (ASH), the GI Assessment and the Test of Ideational Praxis in addition to numerous articles and book chapters on praxis, ideation, and sensory integration. She has extensive experience with children and adults with autism and a diverse clinical background having worked in private and public school settings as well as private practice. She is the recipient of the Virginia Scardinia Award of Excellence from AOTF, The Alice S. Bachman Award from Pediatric Therapy Network, and the Catherine Trombly Award from the Massachusetts Association of Occupational Therapy.**
